FORSYTH COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA AMENDMENT TO THE 2018-2019 BUDGET ORDINANCE

EXPLANATION:

The Forsyth County Department of Public Health received notification of an additional allocation of \$3,326 from the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, Epidemiology and Communicable Disease Branch to enhance Latent Tuberculosis Infection Screening and Treatment.

Funds may be used to purchase supplies, etc. to enhance Tuberculosis screening efforts for high risk populations that are at increased risk for latent tuberculosis infection such as those who live in or have lived in 1) countries with high prevalence of tuberculosis or 2) high risk congregate settings such as homeless shelters or correctional facilities. Latent Tuberculosis Infection is when a person is infected with mycobacterium tuberculosis but does not have active tuberculosis. Active tuberculosis can be contagious while latent tuberculosis is not, and it is, therefore, not possible to get tuberculosis from someone with latent tuberculosis.

Funds associated with this amendment must be spent by December 31, 2018, as they are a part of a federal grant which requires the funds be spent by that date.

This item appropriates the funds to the Department of Public Health in order to be expended within the timeframe. This item also authorizes execution of the appropriate documents (Addendum 551) to accept the additional funds and conditions.
