SUMMARY OF INFORMATION:			
The Forsyth County Register of Deeds is upgrading computer equipment in order to satisfy state requirements. This extensive upgrade was not budgeted in the current fiscal year but funds are available to cover this cost in the Automation Enhancement and Preservation Fund.			
The Register of Deeds Automation Enhancement and Preservation Fund was established through North Carolina General Statute 161-11.3 which requires counties to set aside a percentage of fees collected by the Register of Deeds for use on computer or imaging technology and needs associated with the preservation and storage of public records in the office of the Register of Deeds.			
As of June 30, 2018, \$1,504,350 was reserved in restricted fund balance for the Register of Deeds. The Fiscal Year 2018-2019 budget appropriated \$22,619 of this amount for server costs associated with Register of Deeds activities. This agenda item is necessary to appropriate \$68,095 of restricted fund balance from the Automation Enhancement and Preservation Fund into the General Fund to purchase this equipment. This will reduce the amount of funding in the Automation Enhancement and Preservation Fund to \$1,413,636.

EXPLANATION:

The Forsyth County Register of Deeds is upgrading computer equipment in order to satisfy state requirements. This extensive upgrade was not budgeted in the current fiscal year but funds are available to cover this cost in the Automation Enhancement and Preservation Fund.
