FORSYTH COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA AMENDMENT TO 2019-2020 BUDGET ORDINANCE

FROM: BUDGET & MANAGEMENT MEETING DATE: April 16, 2020

EXPLANATION:

On March 6, 2020, Forsyth County was allocated \$19,855 for the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIEAP) service fund for Fiscal Year 2019-2020, by the N.C. Department of Health and Human Services. This allocation increases the FY 2019-2020 to \$1,606,882. This exceeds the original State estimates available at the time of budget preparation by an additional \$19,855. These funds provide a one-time annual vendor payment to help eligible families pay their heating expenses and are 100% Federal dollars. There is no County money involved. The Allocation period is from December, 2019 thru March, 2020 service months and from January, 2020 thru April, 2020 payment months.

The purpose of this agenda item is to appropriate the LIEAP service funds to match the State funding level.
