SUBJECT: RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF THE REVISED FISCAL YEAR 2017-2018 HOME AND COMMUNITY CARE BLOCK GRANT COUNTY FUNDING PLAN FOR OLDER ADULTS AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF NECESSARY DOCUMENTS TO SUBMIT THE REVISED PLAN FOR STATE APPROVAL (AGING SERVICES)

COUNTY MANAGER'S RECOMMENDATION OR COMMENTS: Recommend Approval

SUMMARY OF INFORMATION:

The Forsyth County Aging Services Planning committee recommended a revision to the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Home and Community Care Block Grant (HCCBG) County funding plan for older adults based on additional funds in the amount of \$25,441 available to the Home and Community Care Block Grant. Of the \$25,441, Senior Services, Inc. is allocated \$10,000; Mount Zion is allocated \$2,941; Shepherd's Center of Winston-Salem is allocated \$2,500; Shepherd's Center of Kernersville is allocated \$2,500; Senior Financial Care is allocated \$2,500; and Winston-Salem Transit Authority (WSTA) is allocated \$5,000.

This Resolution authorizes the submission of the first revised Fiscal Year 2017-2018 HCCBG plan for older adults to the State by the Piedmont Triad Regional Council, which is the Lead Area Agency on Aging for Forsyth County.

WHEREAS, due to the allocation of additional funds in the amount of \$25,441, the Piedmont Triad Regional Council and Forsyth County Aging Services Planning Committee recommend the attached revised funding plan for older adults; and

WHEREAS, upon the recommendation of the Forsyth County Aging Services Planning Committee, the attached revised 2017-2018 Home and Community Care Block Grant County Funding Plan must be submitted to the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners for review and authorization before submission to the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Aging for approval;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the submission of the attached revised fiscal year 2017-2018 Home and Community Care Block Grant Funding Plan for older adults to the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Aging through the Piedmont Triad Regional Council designated as the Area Agency on Aging.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Manager is hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of Forsyth County, any necessary documents to submit the said revised Funding Plan to the State, subject to approval as to form and legality by the County Attorney, and a pre-audit certificate thereon by the County Chief Financial Officer, if applicable.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon approval of the revised Funding Plan by the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Aging, the Chairman or County Manager and Clerk to the Board are hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of Forsyth County, the necessary documents for Forsyth County to receive and distribute the additional funds and implement the activities outlined therein, subject to necessary appropriation of funds, a pre-audit certificate thereon by the County Chief Financial Officer, where applicable, and approval as to form and legality by the County Attorney.
