SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2014-2015 BUDGET ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE 2014 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) FUNDS (FORSYTH COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE)

SUMMARY OF INFORMATION:

On June 23, 2014, the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners adopted a resolution authorizing execution of necessary documents to apply for and receive U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, FY 2014 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Funds and authorizing execution of an Interlocal Agreement (2015-0019-00) between Forsyth County and the City of Winston-Salem for use and distribution of the 2014 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program Award Funds in the amount of \$176,683. The grant funds have now been officially awarded by the Bureau of Justice Assistance.


The County's portion of the grant, in the amount of \$88,341.50, will be used to purchase body-worn digital cameras for deputies, which will supplement existing in-car cameras.

No local matching funds are required.

The purpose of this Budget Ordinance Amendment is to appropriate the County's share of the 2014 Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Funds, in the amount of \$88,341.50, into the Sheriff's Office FY 2015 agency operating budget.

This grant expires on September 30, 2017.
