WHEREAS, municipalities meeting certain population thresholds have established stormwater utilities and imposed associated fees; and

WHEREAS, Forsyth County, Winston-Salem Forsyth County Schools, and the Airport Commission of Forsyth County generally maintain their own stormwater systems and impose best management practices for managing the stormwater on governmental facilities, therefore not relying on the services funded through the stormwater program; and

WHEREAS, the financial impact of these fees limit the ability of Forsyth County, Winston-Salem Forsyth County Schools, and the Airport Commission of Forsyth County to carry out the duties and responsibilities conferred upon them by the State of North Carolina and applicable laws; and

WHEREAS, the financial impact of these fees unnecessarily increases the costs to all taxpayers and reduces funding available for educational and economic development purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners hereby formally requests that the Forsyth County local legislative delegation take action in the 2016 short session of the North Carolina General Assembly to introduce and support a statewide bill to exempt governmental entities and their facilities from stormwater fees.
